BARTLETT CHAMBER OF COMMERCE MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION:

Membership in the Bartlett Chamber of Commerce is open to any interested individual, business, or organization, in or outside of the Village of Bartlett. Membership investment fees are paid on an annual basis, with an invoice mailed each December for the following year's investment. New memberships are pro-rated for the first year.

{Non-Profit organizations are subject to dues investments equal to one-half the normal rate.}

MEMBERSHIP ACTIVITIES AND OPPORTUNITIES

The following is a brief list of some of our current offerings, for more detailed information, contact the Chamber office at any time!

- *Business Expos*: Five Star Expo, (March) and Rolling Down the River Expo (April): Both are business-to-business trade show offered jointly with a number of local chambers.
- *Membership Luncheons*: Held at various times per year. A short program is normally scheduled, plus time to get to know and network with other Chamber businesses. Additionally, a membership table is available for business cards, flyers, and promotions. See Calendar or newsletter for current date(s).
- *Progressive Luncheons*: normally held 2 to 3 times per year, are an opportunity to meet businesses in other Chambers.
- *Referrals*: People call the Chamber for referrals of area (member) businesses and services, and ONLY Chamber businesses are referred!. A card or email is sent to that member business notifying them of the call and possible new client.
- *Membership Directory / Phone Companion*: All members [in good standing as of April 1st] are included in this Chamber publication. Distribution of this piece is to over 14,000 Bartlett households! Additional opportunity for advertising is offered by the Publisher. Members who join after this date will be added to a directory supplement.
- *Website*: all members in good standing are listed on the Bartlett Chamber web site, www.BartlettChamber.com, and a link to the member's site is included with membership. The Chamber site gets an average of over 100,000 hits per month!
- *Bartletter Directory*: In addition, new Chamber members are announced in the Bartletter, a village publication, upon joining, or on Cable Channel 17. [This is dependent on space constraints for publication.] Chamber members are also included in the annual Bartletter Business and Chamber of Commerce Directory, which is distributed to over 14,000 households in December each year.
- *Women's Business Council (WBC)* – a sub group of the Bartlett Chamber which meets monthly and focuses on issues of prime concern to women.
- *Networking / Leads Group*: is designed specifically to promote the group members' businesses.
- *Member-to-Member Discounts* are offered by fellow member businesses, and is included.
- *Business of the Month*: each month, a Chamber business in good standing is spotlighted as the Business of the Month, and highlighted in the newsletter, the local paper, and on the marquee in town, when possible.
- *Business Person of the Year, Business of the Year*: Each year a person, and a business, is selected from the business community that has shown exemplary service to the Bartlett community.
- *Scholarship Program*: Scholarships are awarded annually to Chamber members, member's employees, or staff, or the children of above, pending selection by the Scholarship Committee.
- *Map / Map Jacket Programs*: The Maps of Bartlett are Chamber sponsored programs, done on a regular basis.
- *Educational opportunities*: Seminars are scheduled on relevant topics such as Public Relations, Economic Development, Marketing for Small Businesses, and more.
- *Advertising and Sponsorship opportunities* are available through Chamber programs: Premier Program, Gold Membership, Golf Outing, SummerFest, Scholarship Auction, and more!
- *Community Activities*: The Bartlett Chamber supports the Bartlett community through both Chamber sponsored activities (Fourth of July Activities, Holiday Tree Lighting,) and through other events and programs run by community organizations (Lions Club, United Way, American Legion)
